

PRUSSIAN ARMY RULES

VOLTIGEUR

Starting from the battles after 1808, the Prussian line infantry is equipped with a company of verticigeurs which can be used in skirmish actions following the rules of the French ones.

FORMATION

Until 1808 the Prussian infantry could only change formation when stationary, unless they had to change from column to square. Starting from 1808 he used all formations, including the division column in charges and melees.

ARTILLERY

The one on foot or on horseback takes one turn both to detach the cannons from the tow and to attack them.

GRANADIERS AND LIGHT UNITS

Both grenadiers and light infantry units (riflemen, jagers,

schutzen) are organized into battalions. After 1808 the riflemen were incorporated into the infantry regiments and, therefore, were not used as independent battalions.

REORGANIZATION OF THE ARMY

After the heavy defeat of 1808, the Prussian army was completely reorganized. Some specializations disappeared (for example, cuirassiers, grenadiers) and the regular units were reduced, while less prepared militia units (landwehr) were recruited.

COMBAT DISPOSITION

The Prussian army mainly used the line to fight, from 1813 it adopted the division column to charge.

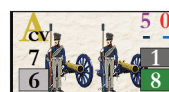
