

# RUSSIAN ARMY RULES

## **VOLTIGEUR**

Starting from the battles after 1810, the Russian line infantry is equipped with a company of verticigeurs which can be used in skirmish actions following the rules of the French ones.

## **FORMATION**

The Russian infantry uses all formations, including the division column in charges and melees.

## **MORALE**

Russian soldiers were very brave. If a regiment has suffered double damage (loss of an Attack tag) or lost half a battalion, it adds 1 point to its discipline value on the morale test.

## **COSSACKS**

The Cossacks do not lose movement points when changing formation and direction

MP = Movement Points Available on clear terrain

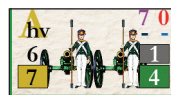

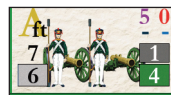
